

Application of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) in a residential setting

This webinar will outline the importance of adapting the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) across the lifespan of all individuals in all environmental settings. This workshop will focus on adapting Functional Behavior Assessment for individuals of determination aged 15 to 83 years old. The significance of using preference assessments and adapting **Antecedent manipulations** (*visual schedules and token economies*), teaching **Replacement Behaviors** (*Augmentative and Alternative Communication devices and Functional Communication Training*) and applying **Consequences** (*differential reinforcement, extinction and coping strategies*) will be outlined.

In order to generalize the principles of ABA, and maintain the programs adapted for the individuals within the residential setting, it's vital to educate the multidisciplinary team of professionals. This is reinforced by collaboration and continuous training in order to maintain the individual achievements of the residents.
